

AME HALL OF FAME NOMINATION FORM

Purpose

The Aircraft Maintenance Engineers Hall of Fame is intended to showcase those Aircraft Maintenance Engineers who have provided significant and distinct contributions to Canadian aviation either as a Maintainer, Supervisor or Manager, Mentor, Trainer, or Inspector.

Criteria

The nomination for inclusion in the Hall must indicate that the individual has a proven record of significant contribution to the aviation industry through their expertise, in benefitting the aviation industry. Those so nominated are to be Aircraft Maintenance Engineers / Technicien d'entretien d'aéronef

Nomination Process

Please complete the application form on the reverse side of this document, along with a separate page (or pages) detailing how your nominated candidate meets the criteria for inclusion in the Hall of Fame, in accordance with the following;

1. All parts of the application form must be completed and signed by the nominator, and a seconder.
2. Include a detailed accounting of the individual's career and its contribution to aviation.
3. Include any other known information such as licences and positions held, and any other qualifications.

4. Include contributions or membership to an AME Association, if applicable.
5. You may include any relevant volunteer or community service.
6. Please ensure that all included information is factual to ensure the integrity of the selection process.
7. If available, include a high definition colour picture of the candidate. It will be required if selected.
8. The nomination form will be sent to your regional AME Association in accordance with the following Selection Process.

Selection Process

Nominations must be accepted by the respective regional Association. Upon acceptance, it is sent to the CFAMEA President no later than August 1 of each year.

The selection committee is comprised of the CFAMEA representative from each regional association, and the nomination(s) will then be considered at the CFAMEA Annual General Meeting.
